Following the evolution of the epidemiological situation in the United Kingdom, the Government determined yesterday evening new measures, as communicated here and to which we draw your attention.

MEASURES APPLICABLE TO FLIGHTS FROM THE UNITED KINGDOM

Following the evolution of the epidemiological situation in the United Kingdom, the Government has today determined the following measures, which will be in force from 00h00 on Monday 21 December:

- Only passengers on flights from the United Kingdom who are nationals of or legally resident in Portugal are allowed to enter national territory;
- These passengers have to present, on arrival in Portugal, proof of laboratory testing for infection by SARS-CoV-2, with a negative result;
- Citizens who do not have proof of a negative laboratory test result are directed by the competent authorities, on arrival in Portugal, to carry out that test inside the airport, through health professionals qualified for that purpose;
- In this case, the citizens will have to be in isolation as defined by the health authorities.

This measure will be updated as the situation develops.

In Portugal, the circulation of this variant of SARS-Cov-2 identified in the United Kingdom is not confirmed, according to data obtained so far by the National Institute of Health Dr Ricardo Jorge, which already include analysis of samples from November and the second wave.
