LATEST UPDATE OF EPIDEMIC PREVENTION REQUIREMENTS

According to the latest policy issued by the Portuguese government on February 27, the validity period of the epidemic prevention requirements for Portugal implemented from February 15 is extended. Passengers entering Portugal on international flights or transiting through Portugal must meet the following epidemic prevention requirements:

1. Passengers entering Portugal from China or transiting through Portugal (except infants under 24 months old) must present a negative nucleic acid test report (with at least the English version) within 72 hours before boarding before boarding. When entering Portugal, border guards will Relevant materials will be verified;
2. Only passengers holding Portuguese passports, EU passports, EU residence cards, EU family reunion visas, student visas, work visas, business visas and necessary travel purposes are allowed to enter Portugal. Tourist visas are forbidden to enter Portugal; documents for transit passengers through Portugal and the materials must meet the entry requirements of the third country, and wait in the designated area when transferring at Lisbon Airport.

Unless otherwise specified, the epidemic prevention policy requirements will continue to be effective. In view of the fact that the relevant information on the epidemic prevention policy will be dynamically adjusted, please follow the latest information released by the Portuguese government in real time.
