LUFTHANSA | AUTORIDADES ALEMÃS RENOVARAM AS RESTRIÇÕES [ATUALIZAÇÃO 04/MAR]

Estimados Parceiros e Amigos,

Bom dia

Lamento informar, mas as autoridades alemãs mantêm as restrições de entrada no país **até ao dia 17 MAR 2021 (inclusive)**. (fonte : [Federal Ministry of Health Germany](https://www.bmg.bund.de/Content/DE/Presse/pm/2021/03/21-03-2021-01.html),)

Assim, nos voos com partida de Portugal, bem como de países incluídos em “Areas of variant of concern” mutated vírus (level 3), prolongam-se assim as restrições em vigor, ou seja, **apenas são aceites no embarque, cidadãos alemães (e os seus familiares diretos) ou passageiros portadores de autorização de residência.**

Lamentavelmente, continuam também em vigor, as restrições de embarque para passageiros com voos de ligação (para países Schengen ou não-Schengen)

Nota importante:

Os passageiros de regresso a Portugal, oriundos de países listados nas áreas de risco 1 e 2 continuam a poder fazer voos de ligação em FRA/MUC.

O “transito” só não é possível, se o país de onde o passageiro regressa, estiver incluído na lista “Areas of variant of concern” - mutated vírus (level 3).

LUFTHANSA | GERMANY RESTRICTS ENTRY FROM AREAS WITH VIRUS VARIANTS [UPDATED 04/MAR]

Dear Partners and Friends,

Good morning

I am sorry to inform you but the German authorities are maintaining the restrictions on entry into the country until 17 MAR 2021 (inclusive). (source: [Federal Ministry of Health Germany](#))


Therefore, for flights departing from Portugal , as well as from countries included in "Areas of variant of concern" mutated virus (level 3), the restrictions in force are extended, i.e., **only German citizens (and their direct relatives) or passengers with a residence permit will be accepted on board.** Unfortunately, boarding restrictions for passengers with connecting flights (to Schengen or non-Schengen countries) also remain in force.

Important note:

Return passengers to Portugal from countries listed in risk areas 1 and 2 are still allowed to take connecting flights in FRA/MUC. Transit is only not possible if the country from which the passenger is returning is included in the list "Areas of variant of concern" - mutated virus (level 3).
