LUFTHANSA | AUTORIDADES ALEMÃS RENOVARAM AS RESTRIÇÕES [ATUALIZAÇÃO]

Estimados Parceiros e amigos,

Na sequência da informação enviada no passado dia 2 de Fevereiro, gostaria de comunicar que as autoridades alemãs renovaram as restrições, mantendo critérios de áreas de risco.

Para Portugal, bem como para os países incluídos em “Areas of variant of concern” mutated vírus (level 3, mantem-se as restrições em vigor, ou seja, apenas são aceites no embarque, cidadãos alemães (e os seus familiares diretos) ou passageiros portadores de autorização de residência. Mantem-se infelizmente também a restrição de embarque para passageiros com voos de ligação (para países Schengen ou não-Schengen)

Nota importante: Os passageiros de regresso a Portugal, oriundos de países listados nas áreas de risco 1 e 2 podem continuar a fazer voos de ligação em FRA/MUC. O “transito” só não é possível, se o país de onde regressa, estiver incluído na lista “Areas of variant of concern” - mutated vírus (level 3).

LUFTHANSA | GERMANY RESTRICTS ENTRY FROM AREAS WITH VIRUS VARIANTS [UPDATED]

Dear Partners and friends


Following the information sent last February 2nd, I would like to communicate that the German authorities have renewed the restrictions maintaining criteria for areas of risk.

For Portugal, as well as for the countries included in the "Areas of variant of concern" mutated virus (level 3), the restrictions remain in place, i.e, only German citizens (and their direct relatives) or passengers with a residence permit will be accepted for boarding.

Unfortunately, boarding is also restricted for passengers with connecting flights (to Schengen or non-Schengen countries).

Important note: Return passengers to Portugal from countries listed in risk areas 1 and 2 may continue to take connecting flights in FRA/MUC. Transit is only not possible if the country you are returning from is included in the list "Areas of variant of concern" - mutated virus (level 3).
